The SaferDeli Virtual Learning Platform

We're excited to announce that the SaferDeli Virtual Learning Platform will soon be available online via our official project website. As part of our commitment to enhancing road safety in the last-mile delivery sector, this innovative platform will provide tailor-made learning materials focused on safe driving practices. Designed to be both informative and visually engaging, the content aims to support last-mile delivery professionals in developing safer and more responsible driving habits, through 9 Modules. The user unlocks the next Module by achieving a passing score on a short quiz at the end of each Module.



Module I: information about two-wheeler riders, advantages they enjoy, challenges on the road, and the human factors and behaviors that impact safety concerns.

Module II: overview of essential components of vehicles, including mopeds, e-bikes, and e-scooters.

Module III: guidance on technical inspections and maintenance practices.

Module IV: proper handling of two-wheeled vehicles, essential riding skills, foundational techniques, and maintaining correct positioning on the road.
